Resolution

The LOG-MANAGER logging utility in the ABL opens files with a shared locking mechanism so that other processes can output to the same file. The ABL leaves buffering of data to the log file to the Operating System.

Workaround

Notes

When a non-zero value is specified for -logthreshold, only one client process at a time can open the file specified by the Client Logging (-clientlog) startup parameter. In this case it is recommended that each client session specify a different file name.
