Question/Problem Description

How to determine from code running on an AppServer which relative Agent the code is currently executing from?

This may be useful for code that monitors AppServer Agents.

Steps to Reproduce

Clarifying Information

Resolution

When the AppServer Broker starts Agents, it enumerates them with an *AppServer ID* property in their startup parameters.

To retrieve the *AppServer ID* value, parse for the '-ASID' string in the STARTUP-PARAMETERS attribute of the SESSION object handle on the AppServer agent itself.

For example:

```
DEFINE VARIABLE cParams AS CHARACTER NO-UNDO.  
DEFINE VARIABLE cParam AS CHARACTER NO-UNDO.  
  
DEFINE VARIABLE iParam AS INTEGER NO-UNDO.  
DEFINE VARIABLE iAsId AS INTEGER NO-UNDO.  
  
cParams = SESSION:STARTUP-PARAMETERS.  
  
DO iParam = 1 TO NUM-ENTRIES(cParams):  
    cParam = ENTRY(iParam,cParams).  
    IF ENTRY(1,cParam," ") EQ "-ASID" THEN  
        iAsId = INTEGER(ENTRY(2,cParam," ")).  
END.  
  
MESSAGE "The AppServer ID of the current process is " iAsId.
```
