We currently use Hotel GUI and Hotel ChUI as project templates. That is not optimal since they indeed have a bunch of configuration that is unique and must be removed. I think all of our customer projects have some of this "debris" left behind. That isn't OK.

In addition, these projects are biased toward GUI and ChUI and don't help with a wider range of configurations (batch, appserver/REST/SOAP/WEB, WebSpeed) and so forth.

We need to create a minimized project as a template. That will be our source of truth for what we expect all customers to start from. Hotel GUI/ChUI can live on top of the minimized project.

We'll need a clean way to take that template and turn it into a working project, both for conversion ([#5000](#)) and for runtime ([#1845](#)). We will work those problems in those tasks.

In a perfect world, both [#10459](#) and [#11667](#) would be completed first.
