I've noticed that some detail reports with really long names create links with longer names than the actual HTML page file names.

For example:

The link:

.../detail\_logical\_flarrearsenddatemustnotexistinput\_integer\_input\_integer\_input\_character\_input\_logical\_input\_date\_input\_logi.html

The name of the actual file:

.../detail\_logical\_flarrearsenddatemustnotexistinput\_integer\_input\_integer\_input\_character\_input.html

I have your latest updates applied (including one with the fix to make safe names).

The result is that the filenames that exist do not match the links that are created, making for broken links.
