The problem was revealed in the regression testing of the <u>#2534</u>. In the changes the conditional invocation of the pushScreenDefinition in the GenericFrame.makeFrameEnable() method was replaced with the unconditional one. As result the test tc_item_stockroom_011 still failed as described in <u>#2534-178</u>. Such a behavior of the pushScreenDefinition looks fragile and error prone.
