The problem was revealed in the regression testing of the [#2534](#). In the changes the conditional invocation of the pushScreenDefinition in the GenericFrame.makeFrameEnable() method was replaced with the unconditional one. As result the test tc_item_stockroom_011 still failed as described in [#2534-178](#). Such a behavior of the pushScreenDefinition looks fragile and error prone.
