Sergey, related to <u>#2944</u> and in general: in Firefox, we haven't found a way to disable anti-aliasing "on the page", via CSS or something else - only on the full browser can be disabled.

#2944 might have something to do with anti-aliasing (beside some positioning issues, I think)- please check if you can disable anti-aliasing in other browsers.
