A MESSAGE statement evaluates its components in order, and terminates this evaluation on first i.e. ERROR condition (silently):

```
def temp-table ttl field f1 as int.  
  
function func0 returns char.  
    return "aaa".  
end.  
  
def var x as int.  
find first ttl no-error.  
message x ttl.f1 x func0().  
message "xx".
```

This shows these messages; note how func0() is never called:

```
** No ttl record is available. (91)  
0  
xx
```
