In some cases, the server-side can have control of a long-running operation (like report generation). The embedded mode should prevent clicking on another module, toolbar button, etc, by showing an overlay panel.

The tricky part here is to determine if the server-side has control without having to call into the JS side each time i.e. TC.getChanges() and TC.applyChanges() gets called.
