The idea is that an optional "maintenance program" can be configured to execute when the FWD server starts such that no other sessions are allowed to start up until this program completes. If no such program is configured or exists, then this is ignored. For now, we should assume this is a converted 4GL program, so the configuration should be a 4GL external procedure name.

This is meant to replace the usage of -1 in a database CONNECT (see [#4175](#)) where it was used for the purpose of system maintenance.
