```

DEFINE VARIABLE d AS DATE NO-UNDO VIEW-AS FILL-IN FORMAT "9999/99/99".
```

```
DEFINE FRAME f d.
```

```
d:SCREEN-VALUE = '1956/12/29'.
```

```
ENABLE ALL WITH FRAME f.
```

```
VIEW FRAME f.
```

```
WAIT-FOR GO OF FRAME f.
```

In OE the value in the FILL-IN is 1956/12/29, while in FWD it is 0012/29/56.
