It would be easier to support a single Hotel project than to maintain two separate projects. We would need to merge the databases and implement some kind of rational approach to merging the code.

The only downside is that the configuration for both projects running simultaneously in the same server is more complicated and fragile. We don't want to discourage new customers from easily being able to use the project as a template for the simple ChUI or GUI application without the extra complexity. This means we would have to implement a smarter template script that can render the project as ChUI-only, GUI-only or merged.

Longer term we will also add batch, appserver, REST and SOAP so that the project can be used for more cases.
