Versions: 7019b aka trunk 14978.

Scenario:

1. Create left-aligned decimal FILL-IN with default decimal format:

```
DEFINE VARIABLE k AS DECIMAL VIEW-AS FILL-IN.  
DEFINE FRAME fr3 WITH SIDE-LABELS.  
DISPLAY k WITH FRAME fr3 NO-LABEL.  
ENABLE ALL WITH FRAME fr3.
```

Or, make a right-aligned fill-in left-aligned by pressing ? (this is a FWD bug, shall be removed in the future).

2. Set the value to 2,345.67 (it must be shorter than is allowed by format)
3. Select 2 and press Delete. The digit is **not** removed.
4. Select 3 and press Delete. The digit 2 is removed instead of 3.
5. Select all with Ctrl-A and press Delete. The result is different from the expected 0.00.
6. and so on...

For a right-aligned FILL-IN selection is deleted with no issues.

This is kind of a regression of the 7019a change.
