ENABLE ALL WITH FRAME fr1.

ON 'EMPTY-SELECTION' OF FRAME fr1
DO:
  MESSAGE 'EMPTY-SELECTION'.
END.
ON 'MOUSE-SELECT-DOWN' OF FRAME fr1
DO:
  MESSAGE 'MOUSE-SELECT-DOWN'.
END.

WAIT-FOR CLOSE OF CURRENT-WINDOW.
```

Prints MOUSE-SELECT-DOWN, while in FWD it prints both MOUSE-SELECT-DOWN and EMPTY-SELECTION.
